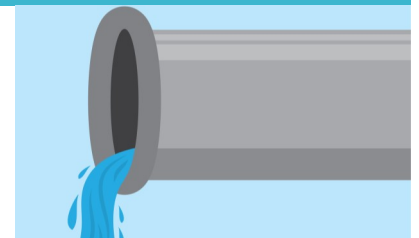

New Western Transmission Main To Provide Critical Back-Up Water Supply and Ensure Resiliency



The Western Transmission Main project is part of Middlesex Water Company's \$160 million infrastructure investment initiative, "Water for Tomorrow®" designed to strengthen water distribution infrastructure and help ensure greater reliability, safety and service quality now and for the future.

New Supplemental Water Main Being Constructed in Edison and Metuchen

Middlesex Water Company will be constructing an underground large diameter water transmission main from Edison Township to the Borough of Metuchen through your area. Over the years, demands on the Company's transmission mains have increased and their importance has grown more critical. This main is being built to supplement an existing main and mitigate risks associated with aging infrastructure. **This project is expected to begin in April 2018 and continue through 2020.** Neighborhoods will likely see construction for several weeks at a time as the pipeline installation progresses. The project route will include Jersey Avenue in Metuchen to Cedar Lane in Edison. Road excavation work is expected to result in temporary road closures and traffic detours but we will strive to minimize inconvenience wherever possible. We thank you for your patience, cooperation and understanding throughout this important infrastructure improvement effort.

This \$42 million project, called the Western Transmission Main, will create a supplementary feed to the Company's water distribution system which will help ensure more resilient water service in the area.
